## Philippines: World Refugee Day 2013



CFSI, in collaboration with UNHCR and the Philippine Department of Justice, commemorated World Refugee Day on June 20 with the launch of a special art exhibit at Shangri-La Plaza in Mandaluyong City, Manila. The exhibit, entitled "Through Our Eyes: The Refugee Experience", featured works of art by refugees in the Philippines, including those from Thailand, Cambodia, Laos, Viet Nam and Eritrea. #### Switzerland: UNHCR NGO consultations

#### Philippines: CFSI hosts coordination training

CFSI hosted a Manila workshop for the "Building a Better Response" (BBR) project, which aims to strengthen the capacity of national NGOs to engage with the international humanitarian system. BBR is a training initiative carried out in multiple countries by the International Medical Corps (IMC), Concern Worldwide and the Harvard Humanitarian Initiative. About 30 representatives from national and international NGOs working in different parts of the Philippines participated in the workshop, held from 6-7 June. The training featured resource persons from IMC, Concern and the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) in the Philippines.
